**NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

**FOR  
CONSTRUCTION OF  
SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM REPAIRS  
MURRIETA CREEK CROSSING  
[PROJECT NO. S0195]**

The Santa Rosa Regional Resources Authority (“Authority”) will receive sealed bids for the **SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM REPAIRS - MURRIETA CREEK CROSSING [PROJECT NO. S0195]** through PlanetBids<sup>1</sup> at <https://www.planetbids.com/portal/portal.cfm?CompanyID=39498&BidID=59122> no later than **2:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, April 4, 2019**. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids shall be valid for 60 calendar days after the bid opening date.

Bids must be submitted on the Authority’s Bid Forms. The required bid forms (Pages P-1 through P-22 of the Contract Documents) shall be completed by the Contractor and submitted through PlanetBids. **In addition, a paper copy of the Bid Guarantee (Pages P-8 through P-10) shall be submitted to the Authority prior to the deadline for receipt of Bids pursuant to the directions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.** Bidders shall obtain a copy of the Contract Documents from PlanetBids. To the extent required by section 20103.7 of the Public Contract Code, upon request from a contractor plan room service, the Authority shall provide an electronic copy of the Contract Documents at no charge to the contractor plan room.

It is the responsibility of each prospective bidder to download and print all Bid Documents for review and to verify the completeness of Bid Documents before submitting a bid. Any Addenda will be posted on PlanetBids. It is the responsibility of each prospective bidder to check PlanetBids on a daily basis through the close of bids for any applicable addenda or updates. The Authority does not assume any liability or responsibility based on any defective or incomplete copying, excerpting, scanning, faxing, downloading or printing of the Bid Documents. Information on PlanetBids may change without notice to prospective bidders. The Contract Documents shall supersede any information posted or transmitted by PlanetBids.

Bids must be accompanied by cash, a certified or cashier’s check, or a Bid Bond in favor of the Authority in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the submitted Total Bid Price. This must be provided to the Authority at Rancho California Water District’s (RCWD/District) headquarters at 42135 Winchester Road, Temecula, California, 92590 prior to the deadline for receipt of Bids.

<sup>1</sup> Bids for this project are being sought by the Santa Rosa Regional Resources Authority, a joint powers agency consisting of Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District, Rancho California Water District (“RCWD”), and Western Municipal Water District, and the Authority will be the contracting entity. RCWD administers the Authority’s construction bidding and contracting processes, and manages construction, under agreement between the Authority and RCWD. As such any references to RCWD personnel in these Contract Documents are in the context of such personnel rendering service to the Authority pursuant to that agreement.

A NON-MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference will be held by the Authority at Rancho California Water District's Headquarters located at 42135 Winchester Road, Temecula, California, 92590 on the following date and time: Thursday, March 21, 2019, 8:30 a.m. Each and every Bidder SHOULD attend the Pre-Bid Conference. Prospective bidders MAY visit the Project Site without making arrangements through the Construction Contracts Department. Note: Bids will be accepted from all bidders, regardless of whether or not they attended the NON-MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference.

Each bid shall be accompanied by the security referred to in the Contract Documents, the non-collusion declaration, the list of proposed subcontractors, the public works contractor registration certification, and all additional documentation required by the Instructions to Bidders.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish the Authority with a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, and a Payment Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, prior to execution of the Contract. All bonds are to be secured from a surety that meets all of the state of California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure section 995.120, and is admitted by the state of California.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by the Authority to ensure his performance under the Contract.

The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the Contract that will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are on file and will be made available to any interested party upon request at the office of Rancho California Water District's Construction Contracts Manager, located at 42135 Winchester Road, Temecula, California 92590, or online at <https://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/dprevagedetermination.htm>. A copy of these rates shall be posted by the successful bidder at the job site. The successful bidder, and all subcontractor(s) under him, shall comply with all applicable Labor Code provisions, which include, but are not limited to, the payment of not less than the required prevailing rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, the employment of apprentices, the hours of labor, and the debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

Pursuant to Labor Code sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, all contractors and subcontractors that wish to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, or enter into a contract to perform public work must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. No bid will be accepted nor any contract entered into without proof of the contractor's and subcontractors' current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations to perform public work. If awarded a Contract, the Bidder and its subcontractors, of any tier, shall maintain active registration with the Department of Industrial Relations for the duration of the Project.

This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. In bidding on this Project, it shall be the Bidder's sole responsibility to evaluate and include the cost of complying with all labor compliance requirements under this contract and applicable law in its Bid.

Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following appropriate classification(s) of contractor's license(s), for the work

bid upon, and must maintain the license(s) throughout the duration of the Contract: Class A, C-34, or C-42.

Award of Contract: The Authority shall award the Contract for the Project to the lowest responsible bidder, as determined from the base bid alone by the Authority. The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding process. If two or more bids are submitted with the same lowest bid amount, Authority may award the Contract to the bidder it chooses.
